Cleaning Instructions

1. Temporary Protection

After installation, care should be taken to protect surface finishes from damage during construction. Systems not furnished with factory protective covering should be protected until completion of project. For systems with anodized finishes or stainless steel components, the factory protective covering should be left on until completion of project.

2. Completion

Upon completion of construction, installer should wipe all exposed surfaces with a clean dry cloth to remove dirt and dust. Factory protective coverings should be removed at this time. Any remaining marks or dirt can be removed with a water based cleaner such as Fantastik $^{\text{TM}}$.

3. Routine Maintenance

Ordinary dirt and smudges on metal components and seals can be removed with a water based cleaner such as Fantastik $^{\text{M}}$. Wipe clean with a sponge or soft cloth.

Not recommended for cleaning are steel wool or powdered abrasive cleaners, because they mar the surface leaving an unsightly appearance. Do not use active solvent-type cleaning preparations, such as nail polish remover, tar and bug removers, etc.
